The advent of a 35 mm. camera of the single lens reflex type, using both regular and Kodachrome film and having the advantage of interchangeable lenses and all the more important refinements of the most advanced cameras in the miniature field, has aroused a tremendous and widespread response. Those who have seen and examined the Kine-Exakta have been impressed with:

- The ease of focusing permitted by a ground glass image magnified and made brilliant by a superimposed condenser to 4 x 6 cm. and, by an auxiliary magnifier, to $6\frac{1}{2}$ x 9 cm. for critical focusing;
- The automatic film transport that winds the focal plane shutter, brings a fresh film frame into position and sets the focusing mirror with a single movement of the lever;
- The wide range of shutter speeds from 12 seconds to 1/1000th second normally and, with delayed action mechanism, from 6 seconds to 1/1000th;
- Automatic exposure counter and film-severing knife, the latter permitting cutting a portion of exposed film without waiting for the entire roll to be exposed before development;
- And numerous other features, among which may be mentioned the beautiful chrome finish and the distinctive, convenient shape that has become so popular in the Vest Pocket Exakta cameras.
