

Integrity . . .

It seems inevitable that the quick-buck boys flourish best in times of keen competition. Legitimate price reductions often help move merchandise faster and the honest merchant uses lower prices to tap a new market which would be unable to absorb his merchandise at the higher price. Thus the lower mark-up becomes advantageous to the seller and the buyer, the former increasing his turnover and the latter getting a good break.

The temptation to substitute lower grade merchandise becomes very strong. The unsuspecting customer who looks at nothing but the price tag is an easy prey! Tricky ads, unspecified equipment, ambiguous use of such words as "late model", "quality lens", or even a tiny and almost illegible notice, buried somewhere in a big ad, reading "All equipment listed is used".


Many hundreds of nameless lenses, supposed to be Biotars, have been sold to unsuspecting customers; hundreds, perhaps thousands of Varex cameras have been accepted by people who were unaware of the fact that they were

buying a camera that had not been imported by the Exakta factory representatives. The trick of substitution for the sake of "special offers" is as old as the hills. Did it ever occur to you that these "specials" are special only because they give the seller a special profit!


How, then, can you protect yourself against fake "cut prices"? Mostly by thinking! Just remember that nobody can give away merchandise or sell it at cost and stay in business!

My friends and customers know that I specialize in Exakta cameras and equipment. This narrows down the number of people who can buy from me. While the average store with its hundreds of different cameras can well afford to lose a few of its customers, I must hold on to every one of mine. I know all the tricks of the trade but I honestly believe that a business conducted in an honest and straightforward way will reward me in the long run. Some people call it ethics, others call it integrity. I just call it Good Business.


