



#### A Switch in Pitch...

Hardly a week goes by without a few letters from frustrated lens owners who want to use Exakta Lenses in a Leica-threaded bellows, Pentax Lenses in an Exakta Bayonet and so on. Mark Twain (or was it Mark Anthony?) once said that everybody talks about the weather but nobody does anything about it. So — we decided to do something about it. Not about the weather but about switching lenses.

We designed a series of adapters which can be used singly or in any combination to adapt nearly anything to nearly anything else. Read on, but carefully and slowly. Before you fire off your order, check it over and make sure you understand exactly what you are ordering. Remember that the piece of equipment (lens, etc.) which you want to adapt TO something requires a FEMALE fitting and the piece of equipment which is to ACCEPT the lens, etc. takes a MALE fitting. But if you want to reverse a lens, both fittings must be made. If in doubt, check with your Biology teacher. Also remember that you can use a series of adapters to reach your final solution, and that adapters of the same species, but opposite "genders", fit into each other. The male Pentax end of one adapter fits into the female Pentax end of another adapter, and so on. Recent legislation notwithstanding, you can't attach one male thread to another male thread. May I repeat: please understand exactly what you are ordering. Otherwise there will be nothing but confusion. Everything clear? Explanation of Terms:

Ex = Exakta Bayonet, Classic and RTL

TW = Exakta Bayonet, Twin TL

B = Thread of Exakta Extension Tubes

B = Thread of Exakta Extension Tubes
P = Standard Praktica (Pentax) Thread

L = Leica Thread (also most Enlargers)

7 = Series VII Thread

"49", "55" etc. = 49mm, 52mm Thread etc.
T = T Thread

Adapters which have a male fitting on one end and a female fitting at the other end are designated by one letter (or number) followed by a "slash" (/) and a second letter (or number). The first letter is always the male fitting while the letter after the slash is the female fitting. Thus P/L describes an Adapter with a male Pentax thread and a female Leica (Enlarger) thread.

Adapters which have 2 male fittings we called "Reverse Adapters". They take lenses in reversed position. These Adapters have the Letter R instead of the slash. Thus "49R7" describes an Adapter with male 49mm and male Ser. VII threads.

Adapters which have a male T-thread fit into T-Adapters and adapt anything to camera threads or bayonets by means of standard T-Adapters. Such T-Adapters are available for nearly all 35mm SLR cameras (Exakta, Pentax, Nikon, etc.) Happy Pitch Switching!

Inst-A-Dapters adapt one lens front thread to a different front thread. Any combination available from 46mm to 58mm. Thus "49/52" gives you an Adapter with a 49mm Male and 52mm Female Thread. It adapts 52mm ACCESSORIES to 49mm LENSES. Clear?

All Inst-A-Dapters are \$3.95 each.

T-Adapters are available for most 35mm SLR cameras. Examples:

#### HOW DOES PITCH SWITCHING WORK?

Let's say you want to use a 50mm F1.8 Oreston Lens in an Enlarger with Standard "Leica" Thread. You want to use the lens in reversed position.

The lens has a 49mm Thread. You order the Adapter 49RB plus the Adapter L/B. Presto! Your lens fits your enlarger exactly the way you wanted it!

What if you don't want to reverse the lens but use it front down in the enlarger? You order the Adapter B/Ex plus the Adapter L/B. Simple?

# You don't NEED a 500mm Lens!

Perhaps you don't need a 500mm Lens. But then, you probably don't need, really need, a car or a television or even a camera. Of course, all these things are nice to have and that includes a 500mm Lens. I know, because I own one. True, I haven't used it as much as, say, my 135mm but when I needed it, I was glad I had it. Why this discussion? Because I had tried to figure out why the 500mm Lens hadn't moved the way I thought it would. I don't beat about the bush. The lens had everything going for it: quality, portability, low price. Out of a projected sales figure of 1000 lenses we sold less than half our projection, about 450 lenses. But our commitment was for 1000 lenses!

I'll continue to tell you the truth: I cannot afford to keep over 500 lenses in stock. As I said, you may not really need a 500mm lens and I certainly don't want to tell you that you can't by without one. You can. But if I offer you the lens at a ridiculously low price, you should buy one. Need? Maybe not. Nice to have? Definitely! The 500mm Optica F/8 preset Telephoto Lens is constructed in two parts to make it fit into your gadget bag. It fits all Classic Exaktas and the RTL. To use it in the Exakta Twin TL, order the Adapter TW/CLA at \$9.95.

In order to move most of the remaining lenses we have reduced the price to a figure that looks like a misprint. Treat yourself to the luxury of a lens that you don't have to have but that's nice to own just the same!

If you want the Exakta Body Service Package proceed as follows: Send the camera by insured parcel post to Seymour's-Exakta, Service Department, 350 West 31st St., New York, N.Y. 10001. Attach a tag to the camera itself with your full name and address, marked "Service Package". Enclose your remittance. (New York City or State Residents, add Tax.) Mark Outside of Package "First Class Mail Enclosed".

If you suspect that the camera needs repairs of defects, do not enclose remittance. Write on the tag "Estimate Only" and tell us what you want repaired. We will send you an estimate. No obligation.



The New Exakta Twin TL has all the features of the previous models. It embodies the same legendary engineering skill and the same excellence in individual precision assembly. A camera worthy of its name!

The basic Twin TL Mount is a miracle of engineering. It has the widest unobstructed opening of any 35mm camera. This means that you can use lenses which would vignette (cut off corners) in any other camera and it means that the Lens Adapters (for Pentax Lenses, etc.) fit inside the camera lens mount, permitting a FULL Focusing Range of all lenses, including "adapted" Lenses and Old-Style Exakta Lenses.

What else makes the Exakta Twin TL unusual? Well, there are the lenses, for one thing. The Twin TL is the first Exakta with an F1.4 Lens! (To anticipate your question: No, the lens cannot be used in the Classic Exakta or in the Exakta RTL-1000.) The F1.4 Lens costs a little more (and is worth it!) but if you want to keep the cost down, you can buy the Exakta Twin TL with the F1.8 Lens. Again anticipating your question: Yes, you can buy the Twin TL Body without lens.

The next feature is the newly developed Light Metering System. It has two CdS Sensors to avoid "guessy" readings. The two sensors feed into an intricate computer "brain" and give you a reading which you can trust implicitly. Like all Exaktas, the meter uses the "true" reading method without mechanical linkage and "approximations." What you see is what you get, or should we say:

"What the film sees is what the meter gets" A push-button switch puts the meter into the circuit and, at the same time, causes your lens to respond to the Light Meter. You can switch it at will but there is a great design idea: A split second after you trip the shutter the meter automatically shuts off (making your battery last three times as long as in other cameras) and puts the lens back into the fully automatic mode. You can take subsequent shots at the previous meter reading which remains "locked" into the lens: Your lens will close down to the same F/Stop as before if the light has not changed. If the light has changed or it you want to take a new reading, just push the switch down and the automatic process will simply repeat itself.

It goes without saying that in such a sophisticated camera the meter and the shutter are coupled to each other. Change the shutter speed and the meter will automatically compensate. Unlike mechanical metering systems, the Exakta Twin TL will compensate for all variables when it computes the exposure: Filters, Extensions, Close-Up Focusing, Bellows, Anything!

What else? Plenty! An All-Metal Reciprocating Shutter of uncanny accuracy. Shutter Speeds to 1/1000 sec. Delayed Action ("Self Timer".) Left and Right Hand Shutter Release. Automatic Zero Reset. Eyelevel

# Older Exakta Lenses in the New Camera

We receive many letters asking about the compatibility of older ("Classic") Exakta Lenses in the new Exakta Twin TL. The following Questions and Answers should dispell any doubts that there is FULL compatibility.

Unlike other camera makers, the Exakta people do not believe in "forced obsolescence". Every new model (since 1937!) was designed to protect the investment in older lenses. What they may have lost by not forcing the Exakta Owner to trade his old lenses for new ones, they gained in unshaken loyalty. Only a very small number of Exakta Owners ever switch to other (i.e. lesser!) makes. After all, Exakta invented the 35mm Single Lens Camera!

Here, then, are the Questions and Answers:

Can I use ALL my older Exakta Lenses in the New Model?

Yes, you can. All you need is the Adapter TW/CLA which costs \$9.95.

Are there any exceptions?

Yes. A few of the old lenses (but VERY few!) were made to fit on the outside of the bayonet. These are the ONLY old lenses that cannot be used.

Will ALL older lenses work with the Exposure Meter of the New Model?

Yes. We said YES! All your old lenses will work with the built-in Lightmetering System! And it makes no difference whether these older lenses are automatic, semi-automatic, preset, or non-preset. All Exakta Lenses will activate the Metering System!

Will my old AUTOMATIC Lenses remain automatic in the New Model?

Yes. We said YES! The new Exakta Twin TL has (in addition to the right hand release) a special left hand shutter release. That's where your old automatic lenses trip the shutter, just as they trip the shutter in the older ("Classic") models.

Do you recommend trading my old lenses for new ones?

This is a loaded question but I'll answer it anyway: I recommend trading your standard (50mm or 58mm) for one of the new internally automatic lenses because this lets you realize the full potential of the new model. What it amounts to is this: the new lenses have an additional automatic feature. You could say that they are "double automatic".

But you don't HAVE to trade lenses. It's just a question of ADDITIONAL convenience. To you it may or may not be worth it. To me it is worth it.

#### REPAIRS AND SERVICE.

Your Exakta is a very special camera. It's unlike any other SLR. Designed by engineers, built by experts, assembled by craftsmen --- the Exakta is among cameras what Mercedes is among cars.

Everybody knows that a Mercedes will take care of you as long as you take care of it; as long as you have it lubricated, tuned and checked periodically. Believe me, the same is true of your Exakta! Give it good care and it will last almost forever. Listen to the advice of a man who has serviced more Exaktas than he can count.

#### First, a few Don'ts:

Don't let your local develop-and-print jockey touch your Exakta. Ever! Even if he's an old hand at repairing cameras, he does not have the factory parts or the necessary sub-assemblies without which even the best repairman cannot service your Exakta. At Seymour's Exakta Lab we have many thousands of Original Parts and Original Sub-Assemblies. No 'universal' parts. Only Original Replacement Parts. And we receive the parts directly from the Factory!

Don't neglect your Exakta! Extremely fine dust seeps into the intricate, delicate shutter mechanism and lodges between the gears. Remember that "dust" is actually grit. It combines with the lubricants and becomes a hard and harsh abrasive. This abrasive will eventually wear out the gears and you will have an expensive repair job on your hands (or on my hands!)

Do have your camera cleaned and lubricated once every two years, more frequently if you take it to the beach or to a dustry place. While we have the camera, we clean the gear train, lubricate it to Exakta specifications, check the shutter speeds, check the focus, check the alignment of the mirror, and check the synchronization. We make adjustments within the limits of the basic service but our special "Service Package" does not include replacement of parts or major parts.

The price for the SERVICE PACKAGE is still only \$29.50 ÷ 2.45 Return Shipping Charges. When you send us your camera for the Service Package, you will greatly help me and my crew by following these simple instructions:

Send your camera by insured Parcel Post.

### **Reverse Adapters**

Why do you have to reverse your lens when you use it for Close-Up Work? might think that a lens will continue to perform satisfactorily when you use it at very close range. However, this is not so. To put it in simple, non-technical language:

A Lens is corrected for "average" distances from Infinity to several feet. This means that the distance from subject to lens must be greater than the distance from the lens to the film. When you take close-ups, the distance from the subject to the lens gets smaller (you are closer to the subject) and the distance from the lens to the film gets larger (you "extend" your lens.) Under most circumstances your lens cannot cope with this situation and your pictures come out fuzzy.

The solution is really very simple: You have to "fool" your lens by reversing it. This means: You mount it with the "rear" element facing out. Now the distance from the subject to the lens can become smaller and smaller because you are actually dealing with the rear part of the lens. The distance from the lens to the film can become greater and greater because you are now dealing with the front of the lens. In other words, you have again established what the lens considers a "normal" condition. The result: Ultra Sharp Close-Ups.

The Reverse Adapters screw into the front thread of the lens and fit into the Camera Lens Mount (or Bellows Lens Mount or Extension Tube Lens Mount) in such a way that the lens is mounted glass backwards, if you will pardon the expression.
