Peter Rabbit The Speedy Multiplier

If you use Color Slide Film in your camera, you have only one single slide for every exposure. Quite often you would like to have duplicates. If you use Negative Color Film, you don't get any slides at all. But more often than not you would like to project your pictures for your friends. Your new friend, Peter Rabbit, solves these problems for you.

Don't confuse Peter Rabbit with old-fashioned Slide Duplicators. From the outside it looks like the old 1:1 Duplicator, but it's quite different: Unlike the old style duplicator, Peter Rabbit does not require Extension Tubes or Bellows. Unlike the old style duplicator, Peter Rabbit does not require a 4 times exposure increase: it does not require any exposure increase at all!

All this is achieved by a built-in Copying Lens which works in connection with your regular camera lens. I found an exciting use for Peter Rabbit: Since it is so easy to use, I "use up" the remaining frames on a roll of film which I want to have processed without waiting to take any more pictures. Usually there are about eight or ten frames left on a roll of film. I atach Peter Rabbit to the lens and make some duplicate slides right on the regular film in the camera. This way I use up every last bit of film and get a bunch of duplicate slides "for free"

Thinking out loud....

The other day we moved some old papers from one storage room to another. There was a Price List of Exakta Equipment from the Year 1958, and several copies of "Seymour's Exakta News" of the same year. The List Price of the Exakta was shown in the Official Factory List at \$399.50. This included the semi-automatic F/2 Biotar. We advertised the camera in The Exakta News for \$269.50 plus \$9.95 for the case.

I did a little "research" and found that in 1958 an ounce of gold sold for thirty dollars. To buy an Exakta from Seymour's you had to plunk down the equivalent of

slightly less than ten ounces of gold.

It didn't take much researching to find that today (that is at the time I write this!) an ounce of gold has just jumped the \$200.00 barrier. It took even less research to find that we (Seymour's) are selling the new EDX-3 with F1.7 Lens for \$259.50 + 16.95 for the Case. Even if you add a few filters, a gadget bag, and some minor accessories, it takes you less than the equivalent of an ounce and a half of gold to obtain the latest Exakta. Now, if you start comparing, this situation becomes even more amazing. In 1958, your ten ounces of gold bought a camera without any kind of lightmetering, a semi-automatic (i.e. cocking type) lens with a speed of only F/2. Today, your ounce-and-a-half buys a modern camera with highly sophisticated electronic lightmeter System, a fully automatic superior lens with a speed of F1.7, coupled to the Wide-Open Metering System! I looked at my figures from all angles. How could it be possible that today, when everything costs so much, a vastly superior camera of much greater actual value costs, in actual purchasing power, only a fraction of the price of a much simpler, primitive camera 20 years ago? Was there a mathematical error in my figures? I kept figuring, first one way, then another, and then a third way and always came up with the same results:

The better, greatly improved and more valuable camera costs today:

- a) only one seventh
- b) only 15 per cent
- c) 85 per cent less

than the old model 20 years ago. Makes you wonder....

You know very well that we cannot keep buying at new prices and sell at old prices. Not for very long, if we want to stay in business.

My sincere advice is: Buy now! Don't wait! And when I say NOW, I don't mean two weeks from now. Or two

months from now. I mean NOW!

They permit a wide range of image ratios without extension tubes, without bellows, and without macro lenses. When used with automatic lenses, they retain the automatic operation of the lens. Best of all, they do not require any exposure increase.

In the May 1978 Issue we began a Column for the Exakta Collector. The response was so gratifying that we decided to expand the column. The interest in Exakta Collectibles is mounting because Exakta was the originator ("inventor", if you will) of the 35mm Single Lens Reflex. 

The Ihagee "Lightmeter" Prism was an early attempt to provide a lightmeter which was always handy. It did not measure the light through the lens, nor was it connected to the shutter in any way. It was a scaled-down version of a selenium cell lightmeter which was built into the prism housing. The lightmeter itself was so small that room was left over for an optical viewfinder.
