
Non-Exakta People!

Reverse Adapter for Macro Work

The average non-Macro lens is corrected for normal distances. To use it for Close-Up and Macro Work, you have to "fool" it by reversing it, making the rear element face the subject. This restores the correction for Ultra-Sharp Close-Ups.

The Reverse Adapter screws into the front thread of the lens and fits into the Camera Lens Mount (or Bellows Lens Mount or Extension Tube Lens Mount) in such a way that the lens is mounted glass backwards, if you will pardon the expression.



What makes the Exakta Twin TL unique? The Jumbo Bayonet, that's what!

There are other cameras, it is true, which have (more or less) the same features as the Exakta Twin TL. But there is no other camera which has the Jumbo Bayonet of the Exakta Twin TL. The Jumbo Bayonet makes the Exakta Twin TL unique.

What, then, are the advantages of the Jumbo Bayonet? Well, let's start with the type of lens you can use: The diameter of the camera opening determines the type, speed, and focal length of the lenses you can use. The larger the opening, the greater the choice. Have you ever tried to use long-focal-length lenses in a camera with "regular" opening? The light rays on such lenses are nearly parallel when they enter the camera. Two things happen: the small opening obstructs the corner rays, cuts them off, "vignets" them. The result: dark corners on your pictures.

Secondly, the small opening acts as a "secondary diaphragm" and can cut the light by more than a whole F-Stop. Your lens may say F4.5 but only the light of an F6.3 lens may reach the film. In the Exakta Twin TL all the light reaches the film — no "secondary diaphragm" effect here!

This means that you can use lenses of any optical formula in the Exakta Twin TL. And, whatever the F-Rating of your lens, the Twin TL's Jumbo Bayonet won't clip any light from it. An F1.4 will be an F1.4, a long lens (even 1000mm!) will deliver its entire picture!

So much for the light path. But the Jumbo Bayonet serves yet another equally important purpose: it makes it possible to adapt lenses with different camera fittings for use in the Exakta Twin TL.

Many photographers do not realize that you cannot merely add an adapter to a lens and use it in a camera of different make. Hardly a day goes by which does not bring letters asking for adapters to use, say, Classic Exakta Lenses in a Pentax (or whatever). While this could be done physically, it does not work optically because the adapter would sit in front of the small opening of the Pentax and add "extension". Therefore, regular lenses could be used only for extreme close-up work. In the Exakta Twin TL the adapter goes inside the jumbo size opening. Result: the lens stays at the same distance from the film as in the camera for which it was originally designed.

This is true for "Classic" Exakta Lenses, "RTL" Exakta Lenses, and, at the time of writing,

for 42mm "Standard" Screw-Thread Lenses (such as Pentax, Mamiya, Praktica and so on). Other Adapters are in the planning stage but not yet on the market.

Does it make sense to buy a camera which forces you to buy its own lenses, giving you no choice of using other manufacturers' lenses? We will let you answer this question yourself when you can buy an Exakta Camera which lets you select any lens, even if it was originally made for a Pentax or a Classic Exakta, etc.

Compare and you will settle for nothing but the Exakta Twin TL.

With the Exakta Twin TL YOU are in charge, all the way!

There are cameras on the market that take a picture the way they (the cameras) want to take it. You have no say, none. Such cameras are called Point-and-Shoot Cameras. In the trade they are known under a less complimentary name which you may have heard. We don't want to offend anybody, so we'll just paraphrase the name as Something-Boxes. If you want a Something-Box, the Exakta is **not** for you!

Not all of us are artists. Perhaps we are not even "creative" but even the most casual snapshooter among us wants to have his own say how his pictures should look. After all, they are your pictures, not the pictures a camera designer considers "standard" (which means inflexible!) That's my opinion. You may disagree. That's your privilege. So let me repeat: if you want the camera to dictate to you, if you don't want to have any say in how your pictures should come out, you'll have to get yourself a Something-Box because the Exakta is not for you.

If, on the other hand, you want to take your pictures the way you think they should turn out, I don't know of any camera that will serve you better than the Exakta Twin TL. It has automation where it makes shooting easier and where bothersome chores are eliminated. But it lets you override any of its "decisions" any time you want to. In fact, it doesn't even argue with people who want their color pictures saturated (darker than normal) because they want to use their slides mainly to have paper prints made. And it doesn't argue with people who want their colors on the pastel side (lighter than normal) because they have a low-wattage projector and "thin" slides look brighter on the screen. How does the Exakta Fwin TL do it? In a very ingenious (albeit extremely simple) way: For so-called normal exposures you center the pointer in the Viewfinder between the "jaws" of the light indicator. For pastel colors (lighter than normal) you allow the pointer to reach the "Plus" (+) Mark. For saturated colors (darker than normal) you allow the pointer to reach the "Minus" (-) Mark. It's all clearly visible in the finder.

And for special effect shots (say, fake moonlight scenes), for silhouette shots, for against-the-light shots, for ghost-image shots and so on, you can completely override or even ignore the light indicator.

What does it all mean? It means that the Exakta Twin TL will take "standard" or "normal" pictures if that's what you want or it will let you take "creative" pictures, at your option. As I said, with the Exakta Twin TL you are in charge, all the way!

Compare and you will settle for nothing but the Exakta Twin TL.

The Exakta Twin TL's Battery Miser

Did you ever forget to turn off the lightmeter in your camera? You are not the only one. The result: Next time you want to use your camera, the battery is dead. And a dead battery means a dead camera. This is where the Battery Miser of the Exakta Twin TL comes in.

In the Exakta Twin TL the battery is in the Lightmetering Circuit only when you want it to be. When you are ready to take a light reading, you push a little switch on the left side of the lens and two things will happen: The battery activates the Meter and the Lens goes into the "Reading" mode. When you take the picture, the switch will automatically disengage, saving your precious battery from draining needlessly. At the same time the lens will return to the Automatic-Wide-Open position with the light reading locked into the lens. For the next shot your lens will "remember" the correct F-Stop as determined by the Lightmeter. (Nothing has been forgotten by the designers: if you decide against taking a picture after the camera has measured the light for you, you can manually disengage the switch!) Compare and you will settle for nothing but the Exakta Twin TL.

Uncanny Accuracy of Shutter Speeds

When you pay for a shutter which says '11 second', you want the exposure to be 1 second. When it says 1/1000 sec., you want the exposure to be 1/1000 sec. The old 'Classic' Exakta was pretty good in this respect. When properly adjusted and lubricated it would give you speeds that were within plus 20 per cent and minus 20 per cent of the indicated speeds. Since this is within ASA standards, it was (and is) considered acceptable.

We have checked hundreds of Twin TL shutters on our Electronic Shutter Testing Machine. The shutter of the Exakta Twin TL is uncannily accurate. There is a reason, of course. The allmetal shutter has blades like a between-the-lens shutter. In fact, it operates like the long version of a Compur Type Shutter and there is nothing more accurate than this type of shutter. When your Exakta Twin TL says 1/125 sec. you will win all bets that it gives you an exposure of 1/125 sec. Compare and you will settle for nothing but an Exakta Twin TL.

How often do I have to move the winding lever to be ready for the first shot?

With older Exakta Models (and with most other makes) you are on your own. You hope you turn the winding lever (or knob) the correct number of times.

With the Exakta Twin TL there is never any doubt nor do you have to remember. Why? Because the counter does not start at Number One: it starts at "Start" (which seems logical, doesn't it?) When you advance the film to set the exposed leader out of the way the counter will move. When it reads Number One (1), you know that Frame One is in place and you can start shooting. No guesswork and nothing to remember.

Compare, and you will settle for nothing but the Exakta Twin TL.

Nobody Loves a Ghost...

The older models of the Classic were not synchronized for those newfangled strobe lights. Later models could be used at 1/25 sec. or 1/30 sec. (The book said 1/60, but...). Unless you were shooting in near-total darkness, 1/30 was too long to eliminate ghost images. And when you wanted to use your Classic Exakta with strobe for fill-in, the ghost image was at times stronger than the picture you intended to take.

The Exakta Twin TL is synchronized for strobe at the speed you use for most of your shots anyway: 1/125 sec. With the Twin TL ghosts have really become things of the past! Compare and you will settle for nothing but the Exakta Twin TL.

No more "Burnholes" in Shutter Curtain!

Did you ever burn a hole in the shutter curtain of your old "Classic" Exakta? I know that all of us did it at one time or other. With the new Exakta Twin TL you have no such worries: The Focal Plane Shutter is made of Metal! The All-Metal Shutter of the Exakta Twin TL combines the advantages of a Focal Plane Shutter with those of a Between-the-Lens Shutter: It protects the film from fogging when you change lenses yet it does not give you the dreaded uneven exposure of cloth shutters, even at 1/1000 sec. Compare and you will settle for nothing but the Exakta Twin TL.

Is there film in the camera?

When you are on a picture taking trip you know very well whether you have film in the camera. No problem. The problem arises when you put your camera away for a while. One day you pick it up to take some pictures. Short of opening the back and possibly ruining previous shots you have no way of knowing whether there is film in the camera

Not so with the Exakta Twin TL. With the Exakta Twin TL you can always tell whether you have film in your camera. There is a signal system which shows white for "Empty Camera" and red for "Film in Camera". Neat, ain't it? Compare, and you will settle for nothing but the Exakta Twin TL.




"Summit" Multipurpose Photographer's Helper

Here, at last, is a universal tool, so cleverly designed, so handy, so useful that you wonder how you ever got along without it. In one small "handful" it combines a sturdy camera grip, a table tripod, a tripod extender, and a heavy-duty ball-and-socket camera swivel.

The tripod legs have neophrene bumpers to protect delicate surfaces but also to prevent slipping, indoors or outdoors. The legs disappear into the body.
