50mm F1.8 Oreston fits ALL Exaktas

When customers come to our Showroom they always single out the huge enlargements of the Shrimp Boats and the Sunset which I took in Key West, Florida. Everybody is amazed at the brilliance of the colors and the unusual clarity of very small details. Professionals find it hard to believe that these shots were taken with anything smaller than a 4 x 5 professional camera. If you have been in our Showroom, you know what I mean. The first question is usually: "Were these taken with an Exakta?" Of course, they were. "With what lens?" With the F1.8 Oreston!

Very few people know that they can use the Oreston in their Exakta VX-1000 or older models. Most people believe that the Oreston can be used only in the Exakta RTL. While the internal automatic will work only in the RTL, there is no reason why owners of a "classic" Exakta should deprive themselves of the Oreston. The lens will be wide open for focusing and composing (at a brilliant F1.8!) When you take your picture you depress a "button" on the rim of the lens and it will close down to the taking aperture. Take your finger off, and the lens automatically opens up to F1.8. Although this is not "fully automatic," it is the closest thing to it and certainly far more convenient than a preset lens. (In the Exakta RTL the Oreston is "fully" automatic, of course.)

The designers gave you an extra "Bonus": The Oreston focuses as close as 9 inches from the front of the lens: The area of a 3 x 5 Index Card will FILL the frame without close-up lenses

or extension tubes!

When you point your camera and push the shutter release button, the Strobe Unit flashes, measures its own light, feeds the light intensity into its own built-in Computer Circuit and automatically cuts off the light after enough light has reached the subject for correct exposure.

All this happens so incredibly fast that the computer can cut the duration of the light anywhere between 1/1800 and 1/30,000 second. No, that's not a misprint. It can actually cut the flash duration to an incredibly short 1/30,000 second, if this "time" is required to give the correct exposure. If more "time" is required, the flash duration is automatically extended all the way to a very "long" 1/800 second. Usually, the duration is somewhere between these two extreme values. The whole circuitry is a miracle of modern Computer Design!

Incredible as it all sounds, it really works, and I can vouch for it. Next time you drop in, I will show you pictures of our pet cats which I took at distances ranging from about two feet (with my normal lens) to more than 15 feet (with a telephoto lens.) I never gave the strobe a thought and concentrated on the cats. Every shot was right on the nose and, as far as exposure is concerned, you could not tell a close-in shot from a "long" shot.

What else makes the Exakta Twin TL unusual? Well, there are the lenses, for one thing. The Twin TL is the first Exakta with an F1.4 Lens! (To anticipate your question: No, the lens cannot be used in the Classic Exakta or in the Exakta RTL-1000.) The F1.4 Lens costs a little more (and is worth it!) but if you want to keep the cost down, you can buy the Exakta Twin TL with the F1.8 Lens. Again anticipating your question: Yes, you can buy the Twin TL Body without lens.

The next feature is the newly developed Light Metering System. It has two CdS Sensors to avoid "guessy" readings. The two sensors feed into an intricate computer "brain" and give you a reading which you can trust implicitly. Like all Exaktas, the meter uses the "true" reading method without mechanical linkage and "approximations." What you see is what you get, or should we say:

"What the film sees is what the meter gets" A push-button switch puts the meter into the circuit and, at the same time, causes your lens to respond to the Light Meter. You can switch it at will but there is a great design idea: A split second after you trip the shutter the meter automatically shuts off (making your battery last three times as long as in other cameras) and puts the lens back into the fully automatic mode. You can take subsequent shots at the previous meter reading which remains "locked" into the lens: Your lens will close down to the same F/Stop as before if the light has not changed. If the light has changed or it you want to take a new reading, just push the switch down and the automatic process will simply repeat itself.

It goes without saying that in such a sophisticated camera the meter and the shutter are coupled to each other. Change the shutter speed and the meter will automatically compensate. Unlike mechanical metering

systems, the Exakta Twin TL will compensate for all variables when it computes the exposure: Filters, Extensions, Close-Up Focusing, Bellows, Anything!

What else? Plenty! An All-Metal Reciprocating Shutter of uncanny accuracy. Shutter Speeds to 1/1000 sec. Delayed Action ("Self Timer".) Left and Right Hand Shutter Release. Automatic Zero Reset. A few weeks ago I received a catalog from one of the large "HiFi" houses. It has four pages of advertisements for recording tape: three-and-a-half pages for cassettes and half-a-page for 8-track. None for Open Reel! "The market is too small," they say, "it doesn't pay to use valuable space on open reel tape."


I am an avid reel-to-reel recordist. We are the serious ones, aren't we? I called one of the largest manufacturers and ordered a large supply of tape at factory prices. Now I can share my bonanza with other reel-to-reel bugs. Buy as much tape as you want. At these prices it will pay you to stock up. Obviously, I won't mention the brand name here, nor the name of the manufacturer. Reverse Adapters

Why do you have to reverse your lens when you use it for Close-Up Work? might think that a lens will continue to perform satisfactorily when you use it at very close range. However, this is not so. To put it in simple, non-technical language:

A Lens is corrected for "average" distances from Infinity to several feet. This means that the distance from subject to lens must be greater than the distance from the lens to the film. When you take close-ups, the distance from the subject to the lens gets smaller (you are closer to the subject) and the distance from the lens to the film gets larger (you "extend" your lens.) Under most circumstances your lens cannot cope with this situation and your pictures come

out fuzzy.

The solution is really very simple: You have to "fool" your lens by reversing it. This means: You mount it with the "rear" element facing out. Now the distance from the subject to the lens can become smaller and smaller because you are actually dealing with the rear part of the lens. The distance from the lens to the film can become greater and greater because you are now dealing with the front of the lens. In other words, you have again established what the lens considers a "normal" condition. The result: Ultra Sharp Close-Ups.

The Reverse Adapters screw into the front thread of the lens and fit into the Camera Lens Mount (or Bellows Lens Mount or Extension Tube Lens Mount) in such a way that the lens is mounted glass backwards, if you will pardon the expression.




